## **Steps for Bathing a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel**

Step 1- Brushing	<ul> <li>Gently undergo the coat with a slicker brush, starting at your canine's neck and running your way down the body.</li> <li>Finish by brushing through the hair at the ears and feet.</li> </ul>
Step 2- Examine the eyes	<ul> <li>When your canine looks at you with soulful eyes, it is an excellent time to return the gaze whilst noting anything out of the ordinary.</li> <li>Look for dilated pupils and dry eyes, and contact your vet to schedule an examination</li> </ul>
Step 3- Clean Canine's Ears & Teeth	<ul> <li>Clean under the ear with a canine ear wipe moistened with witch hazel.</li> <li>Check the ears at least weekly to come across ear infections or other troubles that may affect your canine's hearing.</li> <li>Brush your canine's teeth at least 3 times weekly.</li> <li>You can use a finger glove, canine toothbrush or toothbrush dental chew.</li> <li>Never use your toothpaste on dogs, as it might include xylitol and other substances that may make your canine fatally ill.</li> </ul>
Step 4- Wet your Canine	<ul> <li>Make sure you are using not-so-hot or cold water.</li> <li>Keep the temperature average.</li> <li>Moreover, wet your dog thoroughly.</li> </ul>
Step 5- Apply Shampoo	<ul> <li>Take sufficient shampoo in your palm and gently rub the head first.</li> <li>You can also dilute the shampoo in a cup of water and apply it to your canine's body.</li> <li>Make sure that no part is left.</li> </ul>
Step 6- Rinse with Water	Once you are sure about applying shampoo to every part of your canine's body, it is time to wash it off. Wash your canine thoroughly.
Step 7- Apply conditioner	Once the water leaves your canine's coat, apply the conditioner. Avoid applying it on the skin.
